We are blessed to have the staff, volunteers, homeowners, donors, and board to bring us through 2021! Looking back over the last year, we were able to continue building homes, get our repair program started, bring volunteers back on a (mostly) normal basis, and end the year in the black. That makes a total of 14 families who have paid their loans in full and are still in their homes. We are working on three new homes right now and plan to start one more in the Spring. 
